RWE has finalised the studies required to support the Development Application for the proposed Cattle Creek Wind Farm. We expect to submit the DA in the coming weeks.

At the same time, we have been working closely with Toowoomba Regional Council and Western Downs Regional Council to finalise the project's two Community Benefit Agreements – ensuring that they reflect shared priorities and deliver meaningful outcomes for local communities.

We have also engaged with the Toowoomba Regional Council's Community Liaison Groups to better understand their questions and concerns about the proposed project. These conversations have been valuable in shaping our approach and ensuring we address local priorities.

RWE remains committed to ongoing, open community engagement and consultation, with a focus on building long-term, positive relationships. As such, we are holding another round of community drop-in sessions in August at Millmerran and Cecil Plains, see the next page for more details. We look forward to seeing you in person.
