Special Development Application edition

We are pleased to inform you that the Development Application (DA) for the proposed Cattle Creek Wind Farm has been submitted to the Queensland Government State Assessment and Referral Agency (SARA) and determined as properly made.

The DA and its associated reports can now be found on the SARA application and decision material page of planning.qld.gov.au and our website.

Several additional statutory steps must now be completed before the 15 business day public notification period can commence. While the timeline is not yet confirmed, the public notification period is expected to take place in early 2027.

The DA submission followed the signing of the Community Benefit Agreements (CBAs) with Western Downs Regional Council and Toowoomba Regional Council.

Together they will provide up to \$45 million over the course of the project's operations, supporting legacy benefits, community infrastructure and local sponsorships.

Thank you to everyone who made it to our August community drop-in sessions at Cecil Plains and Millmerran. The two sessions were a great opportunity for the team to meet with community members, discuss the project and answer questions.

Prior to Christmas we will hold further engagement sessions focusing on the DA application and public notification period. These will be held at Cecil Plains and Millmerran and we will provide further details once confirmed.

Install capacity up to **972MW** wind **450MW** Battery Energy Storage System (BESS)



Located about 35km west of Cecil Plains. The area is predominantly used for cattle grazing



Site investigation area of about **20,000 hectares**, with an expected operating footprint of less than 5% of this land



More than **525,000 Queensland homes** powered



Project status: Late stage development – Development Application submitted



Construction planned for 2028 3-year construction period



Targeting 2030 for initial **operations**, fully operational in **2031**

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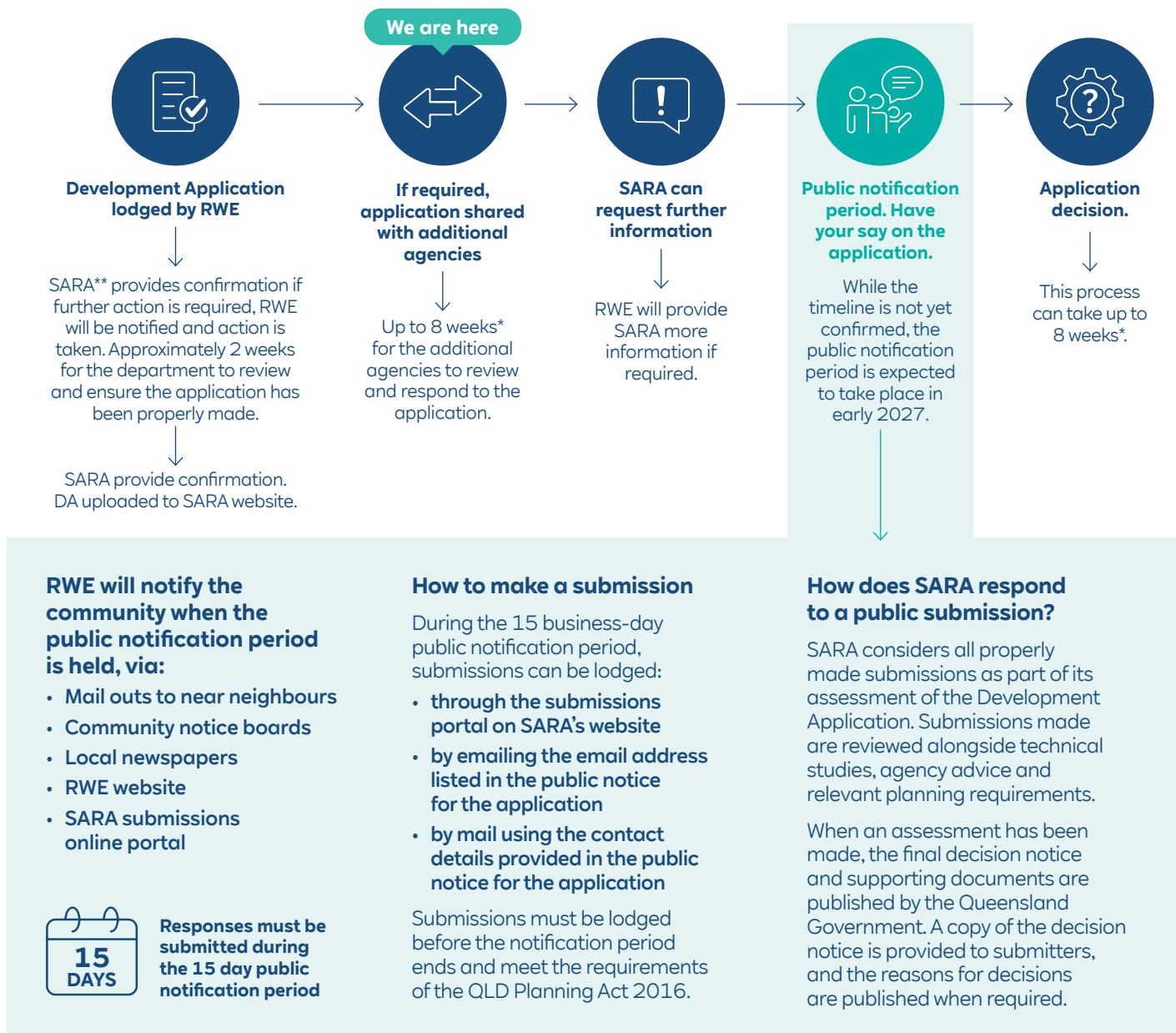
