Do you provide goods or services that may be required for the construction of the proposed Theodore Wind Farm?

If so, we want to hear from you.

RWE Renewables Australia is continuing to progress the proposed Theodore Wind Farm, which received Development Application (DA) approval from Queensland's State Assessment and Referral Agency in June last year.

While we wait the public comment period for the project's Federal Environment, Protection, Biodiversity and Conservation (EPBC) Act application – expected in the first half of his year – we are sharing information on potential work packages with local communities.

We also have community drop-in sessions scheduled for early next month, which you can read about on page 2.

Our sponsorship fund has re-set for 2026, with \$100,000 now available for community sponsorships, and you can expect more information on our neighbour shared benefits program and \$17.5 million Community Benefit Fund in the coming months.

Located about 22km east of Theodore, 50km south-west of Biloela and 150km south-west of Gladstone

240MW Battery Energy Storage System (BESS)



Project status: Planning and approvals (DA received)



Start of **construction** planned for late 2026. Estimated 3-4 year construction period
